

# Popcorn Box

## Materials Needed

1. Small block of wood.
2. Artificial Snow.
3. Yellow Paint.
4. Glue
5. Scissors
6. Graphics (included with this tutorial)

## Instructions

1. Print the 2nd page of this tutorial (the graphics) using the highest resolution printer you have.
2. Find a small square piece of strip wood and test fit the graphic around the wood. Something about 1/16" x 1/8" will work...cutting it 3/16" in length. Or be creative! You can even use a round dowel instead of a rectangular one! Or make a bigger box by using the red stripes alone! Glue in place as shown here, centering the graphic along one side.



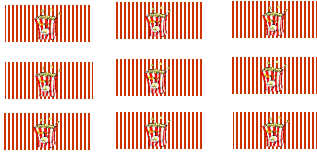
3. Mix some of the yellow paint with the artificial snow. You don't want it too wet...and you don't want it too fine. So add more paint or snow as needed until it starts to clump up a little bit.



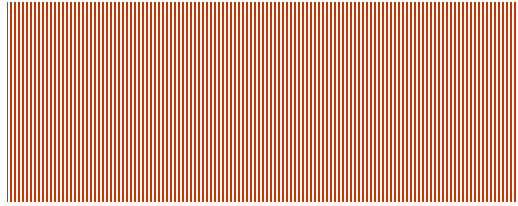
4. You might want to paint the top of the box with some yellow paint. Then add some of the clumps of paint/snow to the top of the box.



5. And you're ready for the circus! Or the ball game! Or even a movie!
