



## DINNER PLATE YARD CIRCLES

The inspiration for this was spotted in Caldwell, ID.



Here's the mini result.

### Materials:

- 1/4" hole punch
- White glue
- Copy or light card stock

### Instructions:

Print the plates and punch out with the hole punch. (Printing on the plain side of patterned scrapbook paper will give you a design on both sides). Cut 1/4" strips of card stock. Apply a line of glue on the upper part of the strip and place the plates with the upper half of the plate extending above. They can be placed side by side or slightly overlapping. Trim the strip so that 3/4 of the plate remains. The strip on the back will be about 1/8" after.

The strips of plates can be used in a circle or to edge a flower bed.
