



Loose Screw Trees

Supplies:

- Assortment of screws 1-1/4" or less with coarse threads and a flat head
- Craft glue
- Green and red craft paint
- Spray primer
- Flocking
- No Hole beads and bunka

These started with a screw hubby found in the front yard and asked if I had any loose screws. It sat on my work table until I realized it looked like a Christmas tree.



Set the screws on end on a piece of tape. Spray with primer of choice.

Paint the base in color of choice. Let dry.

Paint the screw portion in green paint. While still wet, dip in flocking. Let dry.



Trees are ready for decorations of choice. I used no-hole beads and metallic bunka.

They don't have to be just for Christmas! QC had some fun and came up with this group. They're sort of a cross between trees and bonsai. We call it the bride, the flower child flower girl and the mother of the bride.
