



## METAL FENCING

From cardboard (I used a cracker box) cut a strip approximately 3/4" tall and whatever length you would like your fence. Using decorative scissors, trim the top of this strip. Make your cut curvy. See the pencil line I made on the strip.

Using paper punches, punch shapes into the fencing. You can use stars, circles, hearts, leaf shapes, whatever you have.

Painting: You can make it look old and rusty by first painting it a base coat of antique copper and then dry brushing a light blue color and a light green. Or, you can make it look like galvanized steel by painting a base coat of silver. When dry, dry brush black.
