



WONKY CLOCK

Start with a BPF clock. Cut a small wedge out of the clock but try to leave the left side intact. Bend the top of the clock to meet the bottom half and super glue it together. You may want to clamp it until thoroughly dry.

Spray paint it white with either a primer or paint. Then paint the color of choice. I used Folk Art bayberry. When dry paint the face. I painted the hands black and the spots for numbers white. Paint the pendulum gold. And the trim on top white.



Take the checkered printie and cut strips 1 block wide. Trim the clock with these strips. Cut a small square with a flower centered and glue it to the little door at the bottom. When dry spray the whole thing with a coat of matte finish.
