



## WONKY TREES

### Materials and tools:

- Bumpy chenille
- Beads, bead caps, or jewelry findings
- Craft glue
- Metal nippers or old scissors
- Paint if desired



### Instructions:

These are really easy to make. Cut a chenille stem to the required height. There are 4 bumps on each stem.

Select a bead or bead cap to use as a base. Dip the bump in white glue, insert in bead and set aside to glue.

When dry the tree can be left straight or be bent in whatever shape you would like. I even used some small beads as toppers.

I have shown one dressed for Christmas. The chenille comes in various colors that are perfect for various holidays. Think orange and black for Halloween and pastels for Easter. Wooden beads can be dipped in alcohol ink - I used Tattered Angels) to dye the beads.



Have fun. They can be addictive.
